Newform on Linux

Are you seeking newform on Linux? That command doesn't exist on Linux environments, if you come from AIX, HPUX or Solaris... you probably will miss newform. But thanks to the open source projects you have a little hope. I am aware that an open source version of Solaris is available, Illumos, so you can retrieve the source code and compile on Linux. There are the steps:

```
wget
https://raw.githubusercontent.com/illumos/illumos-gate/9ecd05bdc59e4a1091c51
ce68cce2028d5ba6fd1/usr/src/cmd/newform/newform.c
gcc newform.c -o newform
```

Now you will get the binary... I tested that on RHEL 6 and Debian Sid (25/05/2022):

```
emonge@angellodebiansofia:~/newform$ cat /etc/debian_version
bookworm/sid
emonge@angellodebiansofia:~/newform$ ./newform --help
usage: newform [-s] [-itabspec] [-otabspec] [-pn] [-en] [-an] [-f] [-cchar]
              [-ln] [-bn] [file ...]
emonge@angellodebiansofia:~/newform$
```
