# WPA without NetworkManager or alike

```
$ sudo chmod 0600 /etc/network/interfaces
$ sudo wpa_passphrase myssid my_very_secret_passphrase
```

The output will be similar to this:

```
network={
    ssid="mysid"
    #psk="my_very_secret_passphrase"
    psk=ccb290fd4fe6b22935cbae31449e050edd02ad44627b16ce0151668f5f53c01b
}
```

Configure /etc/network/interfaces:

```
iface wlan0 inet dhcp
    wpa-ssid myssid
    wpa-psk ccb290fd4fe6b22935cbae31449e050edd02ad44627b16ce0151668f5f53c01b
```
